Freedom Software is a suite of software applications designed specifically for Local Governments' unique management, control and financial needs. The suite is modular and flexible allowing you to start with a basic system and add additional features and functionality as needed. General Ledger

The centerpiece of the financial suite, the General Ledger System, provides a complete multi-year fund accounting system with budget entry, monitoring and control. With flexible reporting, and an integrated report writer, the system responds to changing user needs without extensive rework. All financially oriented applications are interfaced directly to the General Ledger System through journal vouchers providing enhanced control and extensive audit trails. User defined exception conditions can be established to monitor financial characteristics on a regular basis and provide exception notification.

Budget Preparation

The Budget Preparation system is designed to facilitate on-line budget development and planning at the organization entity level. Access controls restrict users to specific department entries only. Interfaces with General Ledger, Human Resources and Payroll provide budget analysis and "what if" scenarios while managing the entire budget process for the organization. Performance units can be defined and tracked for Performance Reporting. Once approved, the budget is automatically loaded for the next fiscal year.

Purchasing / Payables

The Purchasing and Accounts Payable System monitors all purchases from initial request to final payment. Purchase orders are produced, encumbrances are created and liquidated, cash requirements are monitored, vouchers and checks

are printed, and bank reconciliation is handled by the system.

Accounts Receivable

Local Governments collect a myriad of miscellaneous fees and charges associated with permits, licenses, and fees. Keeping up with them is an important task that often requires an automated system. Accounts Receivable is that system. Using Accounts Receivable, departments can enter charges associated with contractors, residents, etc. as they interact with different departments. Accounts Receivable tracks this activity and makes it available to Central Cashiering for cash receipt processing, allowing all cash payment activity to be centralized in one operation.

Fixed Assets

GASB 34 requires government and not-for-profit agencies to maintain financial transactions for all assets including buildings, roads, and operational plants. The Fixed Asset System supports these new requirements, with complete functionality for tracking the acquisition, depreciation, and retirement of capital assets and interfaces directly to the General Ledger.

Payroll / Human Resources

The Payroll/Human Resources Systems provides all of the required functions of a complex governmental payroll, with optional position control to assure proper hiring practices. A feature to support distributed time entry reduces paper shuffling and increases accuracy. PR/HR can handle individual and organization raises assuring all business rules are correctly followed. Complete integration with General Ledger and Budget Preparation assures accurate financial budgeting and reporting.
